

ArbiterPay Process

Go to www.epiccontestsolutions.com and click the Tutorial tab to view a short video on how to set up your ArbiterPay account.

There is no cost to officials to receive officiating fees through ArbiterPay. An official can manually transfer funds to their bank or debit card FREE of charge. The official can log into their personal ArbiterPay account and transfer funds to their bank or debit card in about 1 minute from a computer. They can move funds to their bank or debit card from the ArbiterMobile app in about 30 seconds. There *are* convenience OPTIONS that an official can choose that do have fees.

Here is a list of the optional fees for officials:

- AutoSweep: \$1.50 each. AutoSweep can be set to move funds each time they receive a payment once a month or when their balance reaches a certain dollar amount.
- Debit Card: A one-time fee of \$4.95 for the card and \$0.50 point of transaction fee. The 50-cent transaction fee is charged by the bank that issues the cards.
- Paper Check: \$8.50 each.

The Arbiter MobileApp:

Renewing your ArbiterPay App is very easy, and you can use it for as little as .33 per month. Here's how you do it.

1. On your computer, log into ArbiterSports.
2. Click the "Mobile" tab at the top.
3. Click the green button that says, "Get Subscription".
4. Pick one of the 3 plans on the left side of the screen. One year is \$5.99; two years is \$9.99 (\$5 per year); three years is \$11.99 (\$4 per year).
5. Fill in the payment method you want to use and click "Submit" and you're done.
